

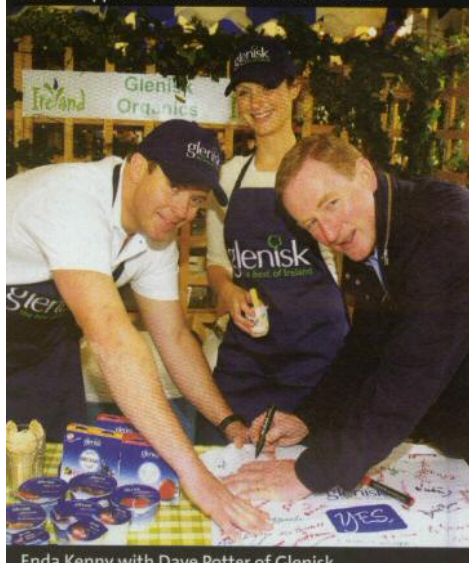


Irish eyes are selling

Bord Bia's Specialty Irish Food Market in Covent Garden was one of the highlights of the Mayor of London's St Patrick's Day Festival in London. Irish Environment Minister John Gormley and Enda Kenny TD Leader of Fine Gael visited the Food Market along with over 40,000 Londoners and tourists. The specially themed market was held in Covent Garden's piazza with over 40 Irish companies displaying their produce.
